New Student Terms of Probation 2023-2024

We would like to welcome you to the CCA family. We appreciate the opportunity to minister to your child and to your family. We understand that you have entrusted us with your most precious treasure, and we take that responsibility seriously. Our desire is to educate your child traditionally, with Christ being the center of all learning.

CCA acknowledges the intensity and rigor of our curriculum and program. It can be a struggle for new students as well as their parents. All new students are placed on a four-week academic and behavioral probation period. This allows time for the teachers to determine and make a lengthy assessment about whether your child is able to keep up and make progress with our program, or perhaps should be placed in a different grade. The probation period also allows you to determine if CCA is the appropriate fit for your child. At the end of the four-week probation period, a decision will be made regarding your child's permanent placement at CCA for the 2023-2024 school year.

Our hope is to see your child succeed and enjoy his/her time at CCA. We look forward to working with you in pursuing success for your child.
